Sale Rules and Guidelines

1. Consignors must be members of American Belgian Blue Breeders, Inc.
2. All cattle must be registered with the American Belgian Blue Breeders, Inc. and tattooed in accordance with ABBB rules.
3. A three person panel will inspect cattle before the animals are unloaded to assure sound and good conditioned animals.
4. All bulls must meet the following requirements to sell.
 - Bulls over 16 months must have a breeding soundness exam by day of sale with current semen test. Bulls must also conform to the Arkansas trichomoniasis regulations. (Copy of regulations are attached.)
 - Unruly bulls with bad dispositions will not be allowed to sell.
 - Unsound bulls with bad feet and legs will not be allowed to sell.
5. All females must meet the following requirements.
 - All females 24 months of age and older must be safe in calf, have a calf at side, have been in a flushing program, or state the breeding condition of the animal.
 - Bred females must be vet checked with approximate calving dates.
 - Unruly cows / heifers will not be allowed to sell.
 - Sale committee has the discretion to eliminate cows / heifers with bad udders, structure problems and disposition problems if they see fit.
6. Planned matings, flushes, frozen embryos and semen are eligible to sell.
7. All naturally horned cattle must be dehorned.

ENTRY DEADLINE: March 26, 2010

- All entries and registration certificates must be returned by March 26, 2010.
- Documentation of birth weights, horned / polled status, tattoos, and all other information must be in order.
- Consignors must provide footnote and breeding status. (Breeding dates, AI dates, pasture exposure dates; service sires with their registration numbers, calves at side-color, horned / polled status, sex, tattoos, birth dates, birth weights, and sire). Please identify OCV vaccinations and indicate if herd is certified /accredited.
- Only high quality show type photos will be used. The sale committee has the decision on which photos will be used in the catalogue.
- Entry Fee and Commission: Commission for this sale will be 8 percent in addition to the nomination fee. A non-refundable nomination fee of \$30 must accompany the nomination form. Send all nomination information with fees to:
